	Scoring key	The scores of items 1, 3, 5, 7, 10 are given “Strongly Disagree” 3 points, “Agree” 2 points, “Disagree” 1 point and “Strongly disagree” 0 point. And items 2, 5, 6, 8, 9 are reverse scored. Give “Strongly Disagree” 3 points, “Agree” 1 point. Sum scores for all ten items. Keep scores on a continuous scale. Higher scores indicate higher self-esteem
