# 4.1 Policy Research and Advocacy

Mr. Keith WONG presented the half-year progress report for 2019/2020. That included housing, primary healthcare, and the on-going research projects. The topic of the upcoming issue of Policy Bulletin would 'Transitional Housing'. The Singapore study trip on primary healthcare would most likely be conducted in the week of 24 February 2020 or the week of 9 March 2020.

#### 4.2 Centre for Social Impact

Mr. Keith WONG reported the progress of SIA projects. The 9<sup>th</sup> Conference on Practice and Research for Social Service Excellence was scheduled for April 2020.

# 5.2 Year Plan of Social Development 2020-2021

Members discussed and gave initial feedback to the year plan for the unit in the coming year. They agreed that the research should continue focusing on housing policy and the development of primary healthcare. Members suggested narrowing

down the scope on these two topics.

- 6.1 Delegates vetting for Singapore Study Trip on Primary Healthcare
  Members agreed that Dr. Margaret WONG, Dr. Kim Wah CHUNG and Dr. Brian
  FONG would be invited to help with the vetting process. The vetting process
  would be started as the itinerary confirmed.
- 6.2 Social service planning and development after election of District Council
  Members raised their concern on recent District Council election results and
  discussed whether the Council should explore ways to put forward the relevant
  social service/welfare agenda in the new district political situation. Mr Anthony
  WONG responded that while we would keep abreast of the latest development of
  the current situation, we should be taking more a reactive approach rather than a
  proactive one given the uncertainty for the time being. The Chairperson
  updated some of the initiatives embarked upon by the newly elected councilors
  and other organizations.
- 6.3 Special Thanks to Chief Officer of Social Development Mr. Keith WONG The chairperson Mr. Bill LAY, as representative of Specialized Committee Members, gave special thanks to Mr. Keith WONG for his contribution to the unit.
