Talent development

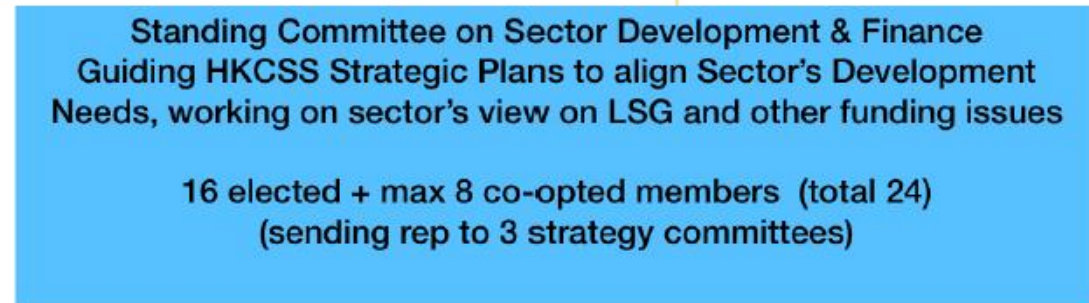
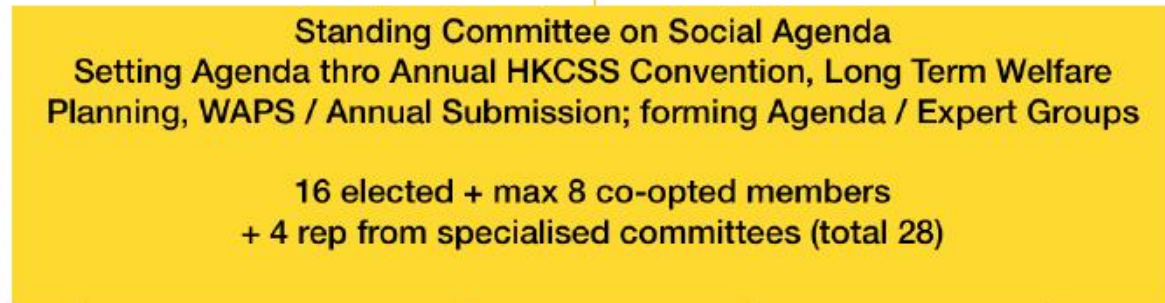
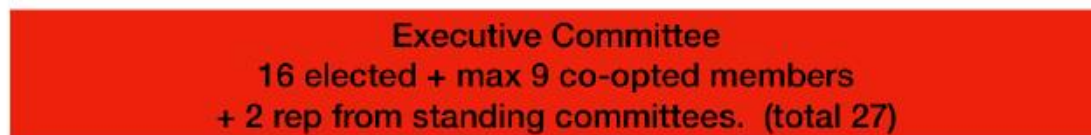
To revolutionize talent acquisition, development, and retention at the social service sector, in view of demographic changes in Hong Kong prompting need for more diverse talent.

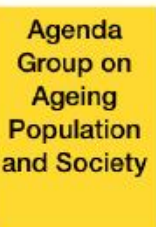
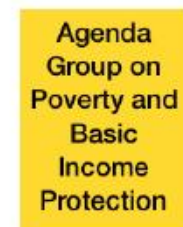
