Key Projects




NGO Governance Platform Project

Community Housing Movement

Improve the living conditions of the disadvantaged by providing them with affordable housing options through the involvement of benevolent landlords, professional bodies and NGOs, and enhance the residents' potential and capacities through the provision of social services.



The Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Fund (SIE Fund)

As an intermediary of the SIE Fund, HKCSS offers one stop support and nurtures social entrepreneurs and innovative projects, with the aims to construct new and sustainable solutions to ease social problems.
